

The funeral of the late President Krzysztof Skubiszewski will take place in Warsaw on 18 February 2010.

The funeral will consist of two ceremonies.

A Requiem Mass will be held in the Warsaw Cathedral (ul. Swietojanska 8, Old Town) at 10:00. Following the Mass, a number of official speeches will be held.

At approximately 11:30, mourners will be transported by bus to the basilica of Swiatynia Opatrzności Bożej (Temple of the Divine Providence) (ul. Augusta Hlonda 1, District of Wilanow, approximately 10 km from down-town Warsaw). President Skubiszewski will be buried in the crypt of the basilica, which has been conceived as a burial place for distinguished Polish citizens. This part of the funeral will also feature a number of speeches.

Please note that the basilica is still under construction and that its interior likely will not be heated. As a result of the extremely cold winter in Poland, the interior of the basilica will be *extremely cold*. It is therefore *essential* that mourners wear very warm clothes and shoes.
